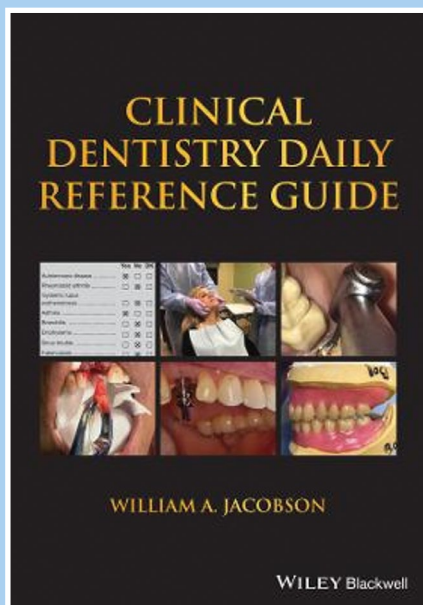

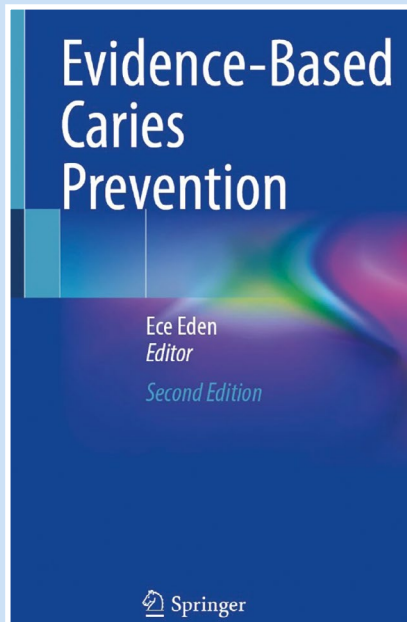


Clinical Dentistry Daily Reference Guide

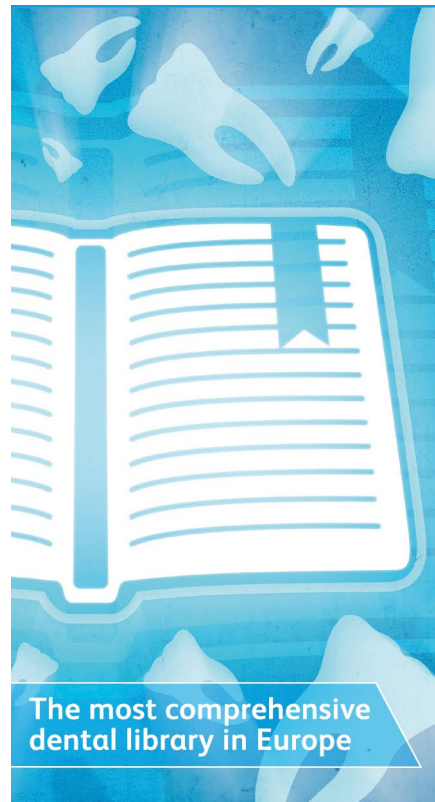
