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In the original version of this article, the orientation of genetic maps placed on the sorghum chromosomes in Figs. 3a and 4a were inverted relative to their orientation in the published sorghum genome pseudomolecules. The orientation of the genetic maps and the associated labels in Fig. 3b have been corrected in both the PDF and HTML versions of the article.
