Error 1: p. 813, line 7 The sentence “(...) a target AUC from 3.65 to 5.48 mg*h/L (i.e., 900–1350 µmol/l*min) according to the European Medicines Agency (EMA) therapeutic window” should be corrected to “(...) a target AUC from 3.65 to 5.48 mg*h/L (i.e., 900–1350 µmol/l*min).” Explanation: the EMA therapeutic window is from 900 to 1500 µmol/l*min

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Error 3: pg 814, Figure 1 On Figure 1. legend “AUC_EMA_grouping” should be corrected to “AUC_Windows”, and “0 = low-AUC,

1 = target-AUC, 2 = high-AUC” Should be read as 0 = AUC below 3.65 mg*h/L, 1 = AUC between 3.65 and 5.48 mg*h/L, 2 = AUC above 5.48 mg*h/L”
