In the version of this article initially published, due to mistakes during file revision and figure assembly, there was a duplication error in Extended Data Fig. 10I, where the top-right 20% Control IL-1 $\beta$  image was a repeat of the lower-left 20% *Jak2<sup>Vf</sup>* IgG image.
