










## Publisher Correction: *Keap1* mutation renders lung adenocarcinomas dependent on *Slc33a1*

In the version of this article initially published, the superscripted footnote 11 was missing adjacent to author name Francisco J. Sánchez-Rivera. The correct footnoting is ‘Francisco J. Sánchez-Rivera<sup>1,2,10,11</sup>’. The numbers along the vertical axis in Fig. 1c were missing the negative symbol. The correct numbers are (top to bottom) –1, –2, –3, –4, –5. A gene symbol (*BiP/Hpsa5*) was incorrect in the third sentence of the final paragraph of the fifth Results subsection (‘Loss of *Slc33a1* results in induction of an unfolded protein response’). The correct symbol is *BiP/Hspa5*. The designations used for mouse strains (KPK and KP) in the second and third paragraphs of the eighth Results subsection (‘Transplant models and GEMMs of *Keap1*-mutant LUAD are dependent on *Slc33a1*’) were incorrect. The correct designations are KPKC and KPC, respectively. The errors have been corrected in the HTML and PDF versions of the article.
